- If you were vaccinated before 17 May and have not changed your number, phone the Call Centre and request a referral to the Sisonke team.

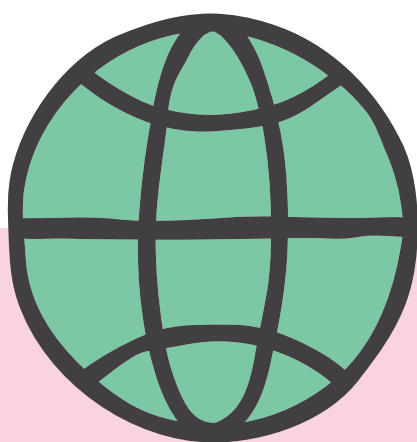
